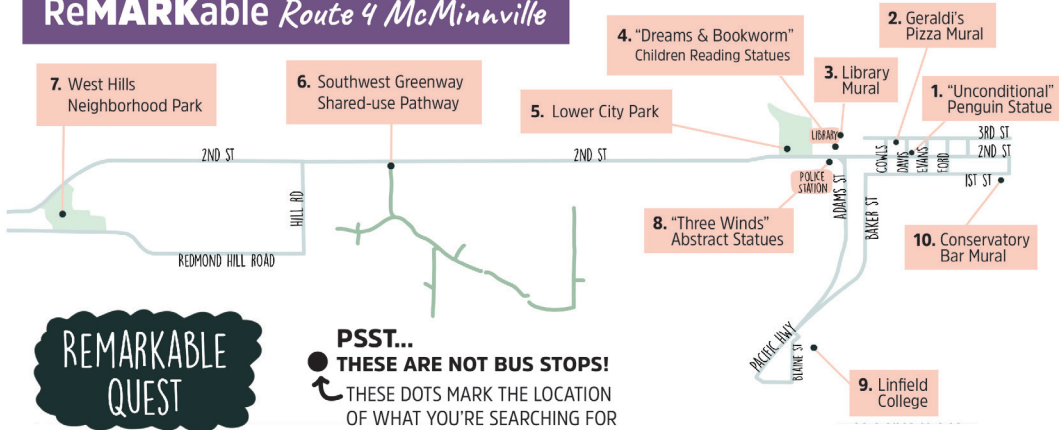

# HOW TO PLAY

## ReMARKable Route 4 McMinnville

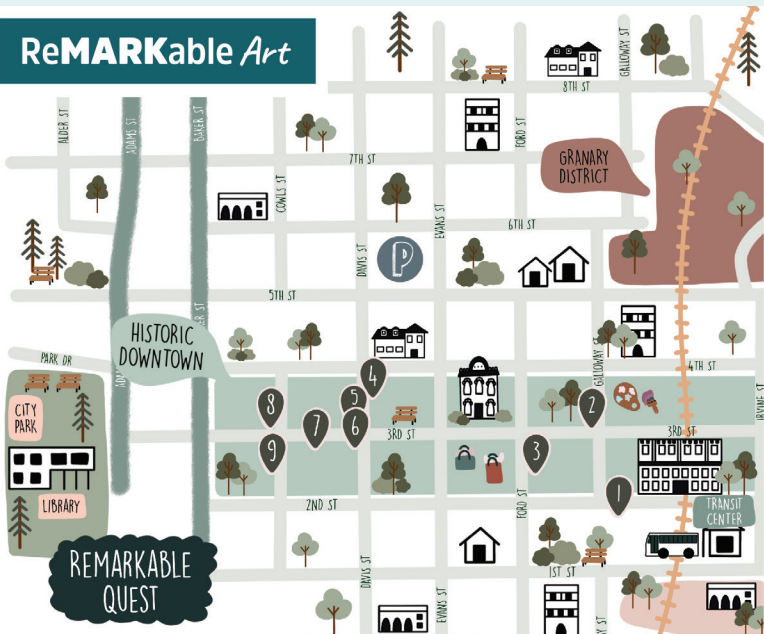


### 1. RIDE ROUTE 4 BUS

- Start at any bus stop on Route 4.
- A map will be distributed that marks the location of ten landmarks relating to art, history, and transportation that will be visible along Route 4.
- Find each landmark and snap a photo. (All landmarks listed are completely visible from your seat on the bus, you will not need to disembark to take a photo).

You will need to remain vigilant to find the landmarks as several of them will pass by quickly at the beginning of the route!

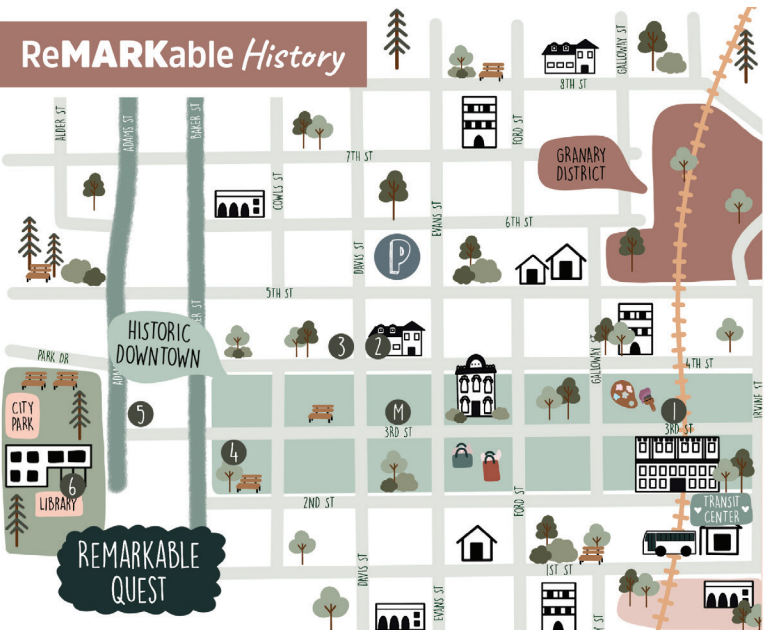

### 2. WALK 3rd STREET

- After route 4 has been completed and you've arrived back at the Transit Center, you'll be required to walk to 3rd Street.
- Use the marked locations on the Remarkable Art and Remarkable History maps to find art installations and historic buildings located on/around 3rd street, take a photo of each art piece and building you find.

### 3. VISIT THE MERRI ARTIST

- Finally go to the Merri Artist on 3rd Street. Inform the staff working at check-out that you are participating in the Yamhill County Transit ReMARKable Rider Quest, and they will provide a note pad, pencil, and eraser (this is yours to keep).
- With the notepad and pencil, please draw a picture of something you saw or something that inspired you while on this Quest. Something that you found truly ReMARKable. You don't have to be an artist to draw this picture, it could be words or a symbol or a picture. This is your chance to be creative.

### 4. SUBMIT PHOTOS & A COPY OF YOUR DRAWING

Once you've taken all required photos and finished your drawing/art highlighting what you found to be ReMARKable, please submit your photos/drawing to Yamhill County Transit (YCT) staff.

**Your submission must be turned in by 5:00 PM on Monday, August 14th.**

Please submit via email the photos, a copy of your drawing along with your name, email, or phone number to [info@ycbus.org](mailto:info@ycbus.org) with

"Remarkable Quest" in the subject line. Or you may print them out and turn in the photos and your drawing along with your name, email, or phone number to a staff member at the Yamhill County Transit office (2050 NE Lafayette Avenue, Suite C) or to a Dispatcher at the Transit Center (800 NE 2nd St).

Once all submissions have been collected by YCT staff, winners will be chosen and notified by phone or email no later than August 18th.

### RULES & SAFETY

#### Rules

- To be selected as a winner you **MUST INCLUDE** your name and telephone number or email with your submission. Anyone who neglects to leave their contact information will be ineligible to win a prize.

- Children are encouraged to participate with their parents, but **only those 18+ will be awarded a prize.**
- Remain courteous and respectful if/when you must interact with members of the public (other participants, business owners, employees etc.).

#### Safety Guidance

- Remain aware of your surroundings, especially when walking downtown.
- Participation in this Remarkable Quest should be limited to daylight hours.
- Children who participate must always have adult supervision.
